POSITION TITLE: NILD Discovery Therapist

RESPONSIBLE TO: Discovery Program Director

POSITION FTE: 0.5-0.6

EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENTS: The Discovery Therapist must be one who feels called by God to provide NILD Educational Therapy and support for students with specific learning needs, as well as support for their teachers. The Discovery Therapist must have a Bachelor's Degree, preferably in Education.

- Encourage the mission of Lynden Christian through student learning
- Commitment to students and their growth

BASIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Discovery Therapist has the major responsibility of providing NILD educational therapy to assigned students. In the implementation of this responsibility, he/she is expected to:

- 1) Conduct regularly scheduled one on one therapy sessions or group therapy for students enrolled in our Rx for Reading and Math interventions as assigned by the program coordinator
- 2) Be informed of the diagnostic testing results as written up in the educational evaluation of each student.
- 3) Employ NILD techniques and related materials that will provide for the individual program of the student or group of students.
- 4) Train the parents of each student in Rhythmic Writing and homework expectations for our one on one therapy students.
- 5) Complete annual testing each spring including a report to parents and setting goals for one on one therapy students
- 6) Complete progress monitoring of student progress for students in the Rx Reading and Math. .
- 7) Keep in close communication with the student's parents, including a Fall parent conference, a written semester report and/or a Spring Annual Report and meeting.
